BACKGROUND

Mothers' Mercy Home project began on May 9, 2001. It was founded by the Mothers' Union of the Diocese of Mt. Kenya South in response to the urgent outcry for a home to cater to the increasing number of destitute AIDS orphans and children whose family circumstances deny them basic needs and a Christian upbringing. The goal of this *Early Intervention Project* is to provide basic needs of food, shelter and education to 84 boys and girls ages 8 to 14. The basic foundation is the Love of Christ.

MANAGEMENT

The Home is run by a committee elected by the Mothers' Union, most of them experts in early child development. They work as volunteers and for the Glory of God. High ethical standards are maintained. Audited accounts are prepared annually.

MOTHERS' MERCY HOME MISSION STATEMENT

- To build the institution's capacity so that it can cope with the needs of the disadvantaged children.
